Corporate Action in 2015



5 January 2015, through its subsidiary, PT Karya Supra Perkasa (KSP) acquired 40% shares in PT Acset Indonusa Tbk (ACST) from PT Cross Plus Indonesia and PT Loka Cipta Kreasi. And on 11 May 2015, KSP acquired an additional 10.1% shares in ACST from CPI and LCK, therefore possessing 50.1% share ownership of ACST.
